Whether it is that of publisher of the newsletter, membership and the organization of the Gatherings.


The publisher of the newsletter has 2 publications, in French and English, to do during a year. Collect articles. Make layout and published on the site

LEGAL HEADING

The Matte and the law

He who will steal an egg will steal an ox.

Is this adage true? In the case of the Mattes, could this turn out?

This is the first in a series of articles that will introduce some Matte who have been in trouble with the law in North America.

The first case concerns the young Louis Matte, 7 or 8 years old, son of Louis Matte (capsule # 6-64).

He would have broken a frame in the house of Nicolas Matte, would have stolen some eggs, butter and sugar on September 16, 1840. He would have entered Nicolas' house again on September 17 to eat in the dairy, would have gone up to the attic, would have stolen eggs and a sugar loaf full of his hat. Coming down from the attic where he allegedly committed the robbery, he was surprised by Nicolas Matte's wife.

He was brought before a justice of the peace on 25 September and imprisoned. At the trial, held on October 21, 1840, the few eggs had grown to 4 dozen eggs, 4 pounds of butter, and 12 pounds of sugar. The search did not allow me to find how long young Louis remained in prison. This young Louis has probably put himself back on the right path since several years later, we find him married since 1859 and subsequently, father of 5 children. It seems that he did not steal an ox.

FAMILY HISTORY

The Matte and the sea

My 4th great-grandfather Henri Matte, his sons, grandsons and great-grandsons were navigators in Deschambault. One of them became a merchant marine and drowned at sea.

My great-aunt Cecile told me that an uncle had been lost at sea. This record proves that this is true.

Name : Ferdinand Matte, son of Jean Baptiste (capsule # 6-165) and Célanire Petit

Gender: Male

Age : 22

Date of birth : 1857

According to the standards of the Maritime Time Training Center, a qualified deckhand is a seaman in the deck department of a merchant ship with more than two years of experience at sea and considered "well aware of his duty."

Ferdinand was registered as a qualified seaman on the Canadian ship Emma V. On December 9, 1879, the Emma V left Portland, Maine for an uncertain destination (see below). No further communications were received after December 12, 1879. The vessel was lost and the crew presumed to have drowned.

List of shipwrecks : December 9, 1879. Date of death: December 12, 1879.

The ship left Portland, Maine, USA for Falmouth, Cornwall or Queenstown, County Cork, United Kingdom. No other traces, missing. [56] [36]

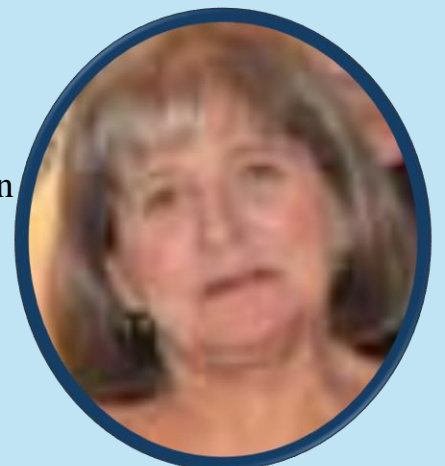

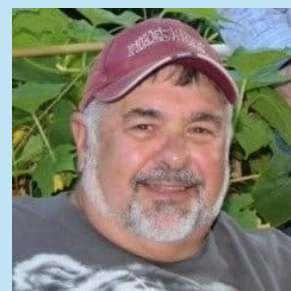

Sinai Matte left Canada sometime after 1882 with his wife and son, Sinai Thomas Matte, and went to Brainerd Minnesota USA to help his brother Gedeon Matte who had a store there and whose wife was ill. His son Elie Matte was born while the family was in Brainerd Minnesota. The family then went to Lowell Massachusetts where their daughter Eva Matte was born. The growing family then moved to New Bedford Massachusetts USA where his son Edmond Matte was born.

The family moved once again to Lowell Massachusetts where 9 more children were born, Ida, Gedeon, Raoul, Jeffrey, Walter, George, Joseph Charle, Louis and Evelyn. Sinai purchased a home on Endicott Street in Lowell and worked as a carpenter for the Lowell School Department. My grandfather Edmond married Amanda Cantin on 15 April 1913 in Lowell Massachusetts at St Jean Baptiste Church, he worked as a tinsmith at the W.A. Mack Company and died of stomach cancer on 2 April 1947 (to be continued bulletin # 15).
